※ Scholarship Continuation Requirement: minimum 12 credits per semester, minimum GPA 3.7 without any "F" grade

Requirements & Evaluation

- Applicants of English Track (A,B) or Korean-English Selective Track (applicants who select English)
- Submission of optional documents (e.g. language proficiency, extracurricular activities, entrance exam score reports, etc.) is mandatory
- Interviews may be held if needed
